BROKER'S COMMENTS

Her designer Jarl Lindblom succeeded with his Metre boat designs and PETER with her narrow beam and fine ends hints at the Rule. Acquired by her current owner to win classic regattas, she has been frankly impressive with a good list of victories. We now consider PETER a real opportunity, with a recent substantial structural refit but no alteration in price.



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HISTORY

Built for a Swedish owner in 1939, PETER immediately won the Round Gotland Race that year. After passing through several hands the yacht arrived in Italy around 2005 and underwent a partial refit at the Argentario yard in Porto Santo Stefano. Results under her current ownership:

- Won the 2009 Overall Panerai Classic Yacht Trophy and the C.I.M Cup

- Not raced in 2010

In 2011 won all the races she entered:

- 1st Overall Puig Trophy Barcelona
- 1st Overall Trofeo Islas Baleares Palma de Mallorca
- 1st Overall Trofeo Conde de Barcelona Palma de Mallorca
- 1st Overall Panerai Trophy Mahon

In 2013 and 2014 Peter won the Puig Vela Classica, Barcelona

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CONSTRUCTION

- Carvel single planked mahogany on oak frames

- Full keel with lead ballast
- Mostly bronze screws and some stainless steel fastenings
- Teak decks

- Refurbished bronze keelbolts

- Chrome fairleads on the taffrail
- Large bronze mooring cleats P&S
- Raised teak lazarette hatch on aft deck
- Mizzen mast fwd of hatch
- Chrome mushroom vent
- Main mast running backstay attached to mizzen chain plate and bronze pad Large fore hatch to access foc'sle eye
- Large cockpit with teak coamings
- 4 x Bronze two speed winches mounted on teak blocks inside coamings

- Mainsheet attached abaft tiller but leads forward
- 2 x Main sheet bronze winches on coach roof
- Narrow bridge deck
- Sliding hatch fore end of cockpit and by trunk cabin access to aft cabin

- Jib tracks fitted to toe rail
- Sliding hatch halfway up trunk cabin to access main saloon
- Butterfly hatch in coach roof over saloon
- 12 V Electric anchor windlass
- 2 x Chrome Panama eye fairleads
